The Dover-Sherborn public schools offers a **cost free** screening **two times per year** for children ages 3-5. These screenings are used to identify children who may need specialized services to support learning in the areas of speech and language, motor or cognitive development.

Under federal and state special education regulations, Dover-Sherborn Public Schools has a duty to locate, identify, refer, evaluate and, if eligible, provide a free and appropriate public education to students with disabilities who reside in our towns.

If you have concerns about your child's development you are encouraged to have your child screened. Screenings take approximately 30 minutes. Please bring your **completed Ages and Stages Questionnaire-ASQ** (previously mailed) with you the day of your child's screening appointment.

If you have concerns about your child's development and would like to have your child screened, you are invited to follow the steps below:
