

How to Connect to WiFi for Staff and Students

Before trying to connect to WiFi, you must make sure your network password has not expired. To do this, log into a school computer. If you are prompted to change your password you must do so before proceeding. If you are not prompted to change your password it is current and you can try to connect.

Apple iOS:

- 1: Select DSRSD as the wireless network to connect to.
- 2: You will be prompted for a username and password. Use your network username and password and click on **Join**.
- 3: If you are prompted to accept a certificate press

TRUST Mac:

- 1: Select DSRSD as the wireless network to connect to.
- 2: You will be prompted for a username and password. Use your network username and password. Leave MODE field set to Automatic. Leave REMEMBER THIS NETWORK checked, hit Join.
- 3: If you are prompted with a message about a certificate press CONTINUE. You will then be prompted with your user account authentication information for your Mac. Enter it and press OK. You will be connected.

Android:

- 1: Select DSRSD as the wireless network to connect to.
- 2: Make sure the the following fields are set to the following values:
EAP method - set to PEAP. Phase 2 authentication- set to None. CA Certificate - leave as Unspecified.
- 3: In Identity field put in your network username. Leave Anonymous identity blank. In password field put in your network password, hit Connect.

Chromebooks:

1: Select DSRSD as the wireless network to connect to.

2: Make sure the following fields are set to the following values:

EAP method - set to PEAP, Phase 2 authentication- set to Automatic, Server CA Certificate - Set to Do not check, User certificate - set to None installed, Identity - put in your network username, Password - put in your network password, Anonymous identity - leave blank, press Connect

WINDOWS

Windows 10:

- 1: Select DSRSD as the wireless network to connect to.
- 2: You will be prompted to enter your school network username and password. Fill in these fields and press OK. Do NOT check the Use my Windows user account checkbox.
- 3: You will be prompted a second time to Connect, click Connect.

Windows 8:

- 1: Select DSRSD as the wireless network to connect to. Make sure Connect automatically is checked.
- 2: Enter your network username and password for the login and press OK. Press Connect when prompted to continue connecting.

Windows 7:

- 1: Click the wireless icon in your system tray and select Open Network and Sharing Center. On the next window that comes up click Setup a New Connection or Network.
- 2: On the next window select Manually Connect to a Wireless Network click Next
Enter the fields as following: Network name - DSRSD, Security Type WPA2-Enterprise, Encryption Type AES
check Start connection automatically checkbox, click Next
- 3: Windows will say Successfully added DSRSD. Click Change connection settings. A window titled DSRSD properties will appear. Click the Security tab and then the SETTINGS button.
- 4: A window titled Protected EAP properties will appear. Uncheck the VALIDATE SERVER CERTIFICATE checkbox. Click CONFIGURE button. Uncheck Use windows logon name and password checkbox and press OK. Press OK on the Protected EAP Properties window
- 5: Click Advanced Settings button on DSRSD properties window. In Advanced Settings window check Specify Authentication mode checkbox. Select User authentication from the drop down menu. Click Save Credentials button. In the pop up window put in your network username as ds\"network username\", so 99903smith would be ds\99903smith. Enter your password. Press OK on Advanced Settings window and Student BYOD properties window.
- 6: When your computer sees the DSRSD wireless network it will connect automatically
