



**Dover Sherborn Public Schools  
EDUCATION SERVICE PLAN**

Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 71, Sections 37H, 37H ½, 37H ¾, requires that Dover Sherborn Public Schools provide an educational service plan to any student expelled or suspended from school for ten or more consecutive days. The student has the right to access the curriculum and make academic progress during the period of expulsion/suspension. The plan may include, but is not limited to, tutoring, alternative placement, Saturday school, or online/distance learning and the student will be afforded the opportunity to make up missed assignments (homework, quizzes, exams, papers, projects) for credit.

The educational services provided are based on and provided in a manner consistent with the academic standards of all students. It is the principal's responsibility to notify the student and their parent of the opportunity to receive education services and to arrange such services at the time that the student is expelled or placed in a long-term suspension. It is the district's responsibility to facilitate and verify enrollment of the student in the service upon selection of an educational service by the student and the parent/guardian.
